Applications are invited in the prescribed format from full-time regular/permanent faculty members of AICTE approved Degree level Engineering Institutions, for admission under QIP to Master degree (2 Years course) starting in 2020-2021 and Advance admission to Ph.D. programme for 2020-2021 leading to final admission in 2021-2022 academic session.

Information Needed to Apply for QIP Admission

Eligibility

Only Full-Time regular/permanent faculty members of AICTE recognized Degree-level engineering institutions are eligible.

Teachers of the Major QIP Centres are not eligible. However, teachers from Minor QIP Centres are eligible for admission to Major QIP Centres.

Concessions, relaxation and reservation for SC/ST/OBC/Physically disabled/ female candidates are as per rules.

Additional Requirements for Admission to Master Programme

A Bachelor Degree or equivalent in the appropriate branch and other eligibility criteria (As per Information Brochure 2020-21) prescribed by the individual Department(s) in the Institution to which admission is sought (<http://www.iitg.ac.in/cet/qip.html>).

A minimum teaching experience of 2 years at BE/B.Tech. level in an AICTE approved Engineering Institution/NIT as on September 30, 2019.

Please note that according to the AICTE notification F.No:37-3/Legal/2010 dated 22 January, 2010 and subsequent publication in Gazette of India dated 5 March, 2010, the appointment of a permanent (regular) faculty as Assistant Professor at degree level, requires a minimum qualification of master's degree in the relevant branch. Thus, applications of those candidates, who have been appointed to permanent teaching position after 2010 without a Master's degree, will be declined.

Additional Requirements for Advanced Admission to PhD Programme

A Master Degree or equivalent in an appropriate branch and other eligibility criteria (As per Information brochure 2020-21) prescribed by the individual Department(s) in the Institution to which admission is sought (<http://www.iitg.ac.in/cet/qip.html>).

A minimum teaching experience of 3 years at BE/B.Tech. level in an AICTE approved Engineering Institution / NIT as on September 30, 2019.
