(a) (1) Firstly, you will be required to bring your downloaded and signed copy of the Online Application Form (*If due to some reasons, you filled-up more than one online application forms, you have to bring the latest and updated one only*), **ALONG WITH:**

- (i) your coloured photograph of size 4.5 cm. x 3.5 cm., affixed on it;
- (ii) **Original Demand Draft** for Rs.150/- (Rs.75/- for SC/ST/PwD candidates), from any nationalized bank, in favour of INDIAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY GUWAHATI, payable at Guwahati;
- (iii) attested copy of your Date of Birth Certificate (if DoB is not mentioned in your Class X/XII Pass Certificate/Mark Sheet);
- (iv) **if applicable**, attested copy of your Caste Certificate [*Please note that OBC (Non-creamy Layer) Certificate will have to be as per format prescribed in our Admission Notification for MTech/MDes programme, and issued by the competent authority on or after 01-04-2016, failure to which you will be considered under 'General' category*];
- (v) **if applicable**, attested copy of your 'PwD' Certificate;
- (vi) **if applicable**, the appropriate **Form in original** relating to candidate's Category [Sponsored (Full-Time)/ IITG's Project Staff/ Part-Time] - *as per format prescribed in our Admission Notification for MTech/MDes programme*;
- (vii) attested copies of Pass Certificates and Mark Sheets [ **Mark Sheets should be complete for all semesters/years** of your educational qualifications (from Class X onwards)];
- (viii) **as may be applicable**, copy of your qualifying degree Grade Point Average to Percentage conversion certificate( or proof thereof);
- (ix) **as may be applicable**, attested copy of your GATE Score Card (*This is a MUST, unless your qualifying degree is M.E. or M.Tech., Or you are a BTech degree holder from an IIT with a minimum CPI of 8.0*);
- (x) **as may be applicable**, attested copy of Certificates relating to your professional experience etc.;

(2) **As may be applicable** , you are also required to bring all **ORIGINAL documents relating to** points (a)(1) (iii), (iv), (v), (vi), (vii), (viii), (ix) and (x), for verification on the day of your **Counseling/Written Test/Interview/ Written Test and Interview.**

(b) If you have appeared in the qualifying degree examination and your results are awaited OR you are going to appear in all the subjects of your qualifying degree examination before 14-07-2017, you may appear in the **Counseling/Written Test/Interview/Written Test and Interview.** Please note that, for such candidates, selections shall be provisional. And all provisionally selected candidates shall have to produce their original pass certificates and Mark Sheets of the qualifying degree examination latest by **21-08-2017**, for regularization – failure to which their admissions shall stand automatically cancelled.

Each correct answer will fetch ONE mark while NEGATIVE HALF mark will be awarded for each wrong/incorrect answer and NO mark will be awarded if the question is not attempted. Use of scientific calculator is allowed while use of mobile as calculator not permitted.

**Water/Wastewater:** Quality standards, basic unit processes and operations for water treatment. Drinking water standards, water requirements, basic unit operations and unit processes for surface water treatment, distribution of water. Sewage and sewerage treatment, quantity and characteristics of wastewater. Primary, secondary and tertiary treatment of wastewater, sludge disposal, effluent discharge standards. **Air Pollution:** Types of pollutants, their sources and impacts, air pollution meteorology, air pollution control, air quality standards and limits. **Municipal Solid Wastes:** Characteristics, generation, collection and transportation of solid wastes, engineered systems for solid waste management (reuse/recycle, energy recovery, treatment and disposal).

**Elementary Geology:** Carbon cycle; Hydrogen cycle; Nitrogen cycle; Fold; Faults; Minerals and rocks; Coal; Petroleum; Greenhouse gases and effects; Atmosphere; Ocean system; Earthquake, volcanoes and other natural disasters, River system; Groundwater.

**Elementary Civil Engineering:** Fluid properties; Principle of conservation of mass; Momentum and energy; Applications of momentum and Bernoulli's equation; Laminar and turbulent flow; Soil properties; Stress and strain; Water quality and basic units processes for water treatment; Air and water pollution; Linear and angular measurements in surveying.
