With reference to your application for admission in to **PhD** programme of the Department of DESIGN, you are hereby requested to appear for **Written Test and Interview** as per the details given below:

Your application will be assessed based on the following points:

- (A) Statement of Purpose (SOP),
- (B) Written exam
- (C) A presentation

Submit a soft copy of Statement of Purpose (SOP) to debayan@iitg.ac.in latest by 20.05.2019 and also bring hard copy of SOP on the day of written test and interview (Submission of SOP by email is compulsory failing which it might not be evaluated for final candidature assessment). The SOP should be restricted to a maximum of 600 words.

A written examination will be conducted prior to the presentation session, with objectives of evaluating (i) communication skills (ii) orientation towards research and (iii) Design awareness.

Each candidate will be given 10 minutes to present their research proposal using PowerPoint/Flash/PDF/Prezi presentation followed by 05 minutes of Question and answer session with the panel members. Your presentation should include the following points -

- Self-introduction with academic qualification and job experience
- Topic of the tentative research area
 - Introduction to proposed research area
 - Research gap identification supported by literature review
 - Proposed problem statement
 - Aim and Objectives
 - Tentative approach to pursue proposed aim and objectives
 - References

Your proposal will be evaluated based on its strength to contribute/ align to the overall research objectives of the department.

Your proposal should justify why Department of Design should accept your application for the admission in doctoral program of Department of Design

Further you are encouraged to bring with you relevant documents of your previous work that reflects your interest.

Please note the following:

Firstly, you will be required to bring your downloaded and signed copy of the Online Application Form

ALONG WITH:

1. Your colour photograph of size 4.5 cm. x 3.5 cm., affixed on it;
2. Self-Attested copy of your Date of Birth Certificate (only if DoB is not mentioned in your Class X/XII Pass Certificate/Mark Sheet);
3. Self-Attested copy of your category certificate (only for EWS/OBC(NCL)/SC/ST), if applicable
4. Self-Attested copy of your 'PwD' Certificate, if applicable
5. The appropriate Form in original relating to candidate's Category [Sponsored/Employed/ Project Staff/ External] - *as per format prescribed in our Admission Notification for PhD programme*, if applicable
6. Self-Attested copies of Pass Certificates and Mark Sheets of your educational qualifications (from Class X onwards)];
7. Self -Attested copy of your valid GATE/CEED/NET(JRF)/INSPIRE Score Card, if applicable
8. Self -Attested copy of certificates relating to your professional experience etc. If applicable

You are also required to bring all **ORIGINAL documents mentioned above** for verification on the day of your **Written Test and Interview**.

The candidates who have not completed qualifying degree may appear in the Written Test and Interview,

- if you have appeared in the qualifying degree examination and your results are awaited
- OR
- if you are going to appear in all the subjects of your qualifying degree examination before **13-07-2019**.

Please note that, for such candidates, selections shall be provisional. All provisionally selected candidates shall have to produce their original pass certificates and Mark Sheets of the qualifying degree examination latest by **20-08-2019**, for regularization – failure to which their admissions shall stand automatically cancelled.


Accommodation: Accommodation* may be provided in the IITG Hostels (*for candidates only. Parents / Guardians will not be provided accommodation in any case).
