Please use the Times New Roman font. Left- and right justify your columns. Use tables and figures to adjust column length. On the last page of your paper, adjust the lengths of the columns so that they are equal. Use automatic hyphenation and check spelling. The font sizes are as follows:

Title: Bold, 24pt. Author names: 11pt.

Author addresses: Normal, 10pt.

Abstract: 9pt, bold Abstract Heading: Italic. Section Titles: Upper case, 8pt.

First letters in section titles: Upper Case, 10pt

Subsection Titles: Italic, 10pt. Body of the paper: Normal, 10pt.

Reference: Normal 8pt.

References Caption: No section number, Italics, 12pt. Gap between authors' addresses & text body: Two lines.

Spacing between sections: One line. Inter paragraph spacing: One line. Interline spacing: Single space.

B. Margins

Top margin: 19mm Bottom margin: 43mm Left and right margins: 13mm Column separation: 4mm Column width: 88mm

III. FIGURES AND TABLES

Position figures and tables at the tops and bottoms of columns. Avoid placing them in the middle of columns. Large figures and tables may span across both columns. Figure captions should be centered below the figures; table captions should be centered above. Figure labels should be legible, about 10-point type. Avoid scanned figures in your paper.
