## IIT Guwahati

Indian Institute of Technology Guwahati, the sixth member of the IIT fraternity, was established in 1994 and academic programs commenced in 1995. At present the Institute has eleven departments and three inter-disciplinary academic centres covering all the major engineering, science and humanities disciplines. Presently, IIT Guwahati has one of the finest world class infrastructures with state of the art engineering and scientific instruments for carrying out advanced research.

It is considered as one of the most beautiful campuses sprawling around 285 hectares of land on the north bank of the river Brahmaputra. The campus is about 25 Km from the heart of the city. The city of Guwahati is the gateway to North East India and connected to many major cities in the country by rail and air. Weather during summer is hot and humid with temperatures varying between 25<sup>o</sup>C-32<sup>o</sup>C. Summer span is usually from May to September.
