The statement is a video submission statement, which expects the following rules to be followed:

The hostels are expected to make a video about our campus to showcase the natural beauty of it. The rules are as follows.

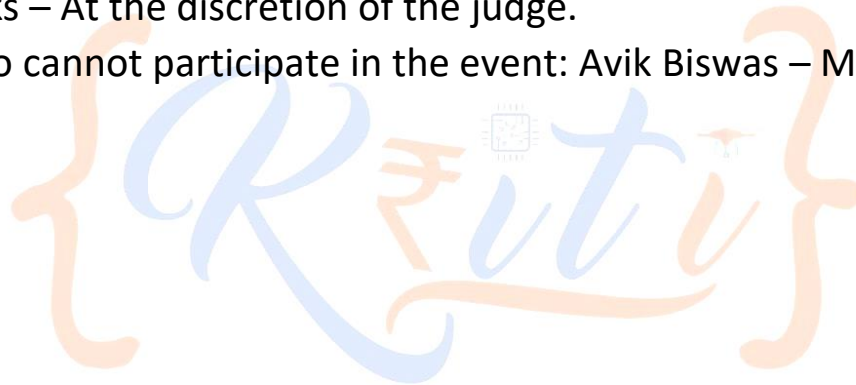
1. The total marks will be out of 500.
2. The entire video should not exceed more than 3 minutes.
3. All the content used in the video must be generated after the release of this statement. No prior material can be used. If proved to have used earlier material, you would be disqualified.
4. We expect a time lapse as a part of the video. The time lapse should not exceed 60 seconds. If it exceeds this duration, every second extra will cost you 10 marks from the total marks you earn.
5. Video is to be submitted in .mp4 format. Those who do not follow this rule will be disqualified from the competition.
6. Video quality is expected to be 1080p. A 720p video will also be judged but 50 marks will be deducted. If the video is of higher quality, no extra marks will be awarded.
7. Any background music can be used but it will also be judged with respect to the compatibility with the video. Please note that only open source music can be used.
8. A professor will judge the event.
9. The date of submission is 11 October 2018 at midnight.
10. For every minute of late submission that percentage of marks will be deducted. 100 minutes after midnight, your submission will not be considered at all.
11. The threshold for the competition are the following:
 - a. Time-lapse should be for at least 30 seconds.
 - b. Video should be for at least 2 min.
 - c. Score should be above 200.
 - d. Video quality should be at least 720p

12. The submission to you atleast 3 days prior to the deadline
13. The decisions of the Club secretary on any issue arising during submission is final.

Marking scheme is as follows:

1. 100 Marks – Time lapse.
2. 100 Marks – Video transitions and their compatibility.
3. 50 Marks – Theme conveyed by the video.
4. 50 Marks – Audio compatibility with the video.
5. 100 Marks – Creativity of the shot.
6. 100 Marks – At the discretion of the judge.
