For M.A. and M.Sc. Students:

- Jadav Prasad Chaliha Award for Academic Excellence: The topper (in terms of Cumulative Performance Index) at the end the first year in MSc Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics & Computing, and MA in Development Studies, will be awarded 'Jadav Prasad Chaliha Award for Academic Excellence', with a cash prize of Rs 20,000/- each.
- Jadav Prasad Chaliha Merit-cum-Means Award: The topper (in terms of Cumulative Performance Index) at the end the first year in MSc Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics & Computing, and MA in Development Studies, amongst those students with yearly family income lower than Rs 4.5 lakh, will be awarded 'Jadav Prasad Chaliha Merit-cum-Means Award', with a cash award of Rs 20,000/- each.
- In case the same student qualifies for both 'Jadav Prasad Chaliha Award for Academic Excellence' and 'Jadav Prasad Chaliha Merit-cum-Means Award', then the latter will be given to the student with the second highest CPI in that category.

All the above mentioned two awards will be presented during the Independence Day celebrations at IITG.

• <u>Institute Silver Medal:</u> The Institute Silver Medals, one for each disciplines under BTech, BDes, Master of Science (MSc) and Master of Arts (MA) programmes of the Institute will be awarded to each year to the student who ranks first, obtaining the highest Cumulative Performance Index (CPI) among all graduating students in his/her discipline in that year. In case of a tie in the CPI, the medal will be awarded to the student who has earned the highest number of credits with 10 grade points.

The Institute Silver Medal will be presented during the Convocation of the Institute.
