Short-listing Criteria for calling candidates to the Interview

For all candidates:

Eligibility criteria such as Qualifying Degree, Minimum CPI or Percentage of Marks and all other requirements as mentioned in the admission advertisement/ notification vide https://www.iitg.ac.in/acad/admission2021/phd/eligibility.php

In addition to that

For admission to the PhD Programme in Chemical Engineering Department, a candidate must satisfy either:

- i. Master's degree in Engineering/Technology/Medical Sciences/Veterinary Sciences/Pharmacy in a relevant area with a minimum Cumulative Performance Index (CPI) of either 6.0 or 60% of marks.
- ii. Four-year Bachelor's degree in Engineering/Technology/Medical Sciences or equivalent in a relevant area with a minimum CPI of either 7.0 or 70% of marks.
- iii. **Relaxation for SC/ST/PwD Candidates:** Eligibility criteria will be relaxed by 5% marks or 0.5 CPI for SC/ST/PwD applicants
- iv. The OBC-NCL candidates must have OBC-NCL certificates issued on or after 01.04.2020

For Regular Category Candidates:

Same as Above and

Candidates still to appear in their qualifying degree examinations may also apply, provided they appear in all their qualifying degree examinations and complete all requirements for their degrees before joining the Institute. If selected, such candidates shall be admitted provisionally, and they will have to furnish the results of their qualifying degree examinations within one month from the date of joining the Institute. Further, they must fulfil the minimum requirements of marks/CPI, and other conditions like valid GATE score as mentioned under eligibility requirements for respective programs. Failure to fulfil any of these requirements shall automatically result in cancellation of admission.

For Part-Time, Sponsored (Full-Time), Self-Financed (Full-Time), External Registration Category Candidates: As per IIT Guwahati Guidelines given in :
