Frequently Asked Questions About M.Tech. Admission

- Am I shortlisted?
List of shortlisted candidates and shortlisting criteria is available on the M.Tech. admission webpage. We have also sent email notification to the shortlisted candidates. If you believe that you meet the shortlisting criteria but your name does not appear in the list, then please contact us (cseadmissions@iitg.ac.in).
- I am shortlisted. What should I do next?
You have to attend the counselling session on May 15, 2019.
- If the admission is based on the GATE score, then what is the reason for organizing a counselling session?
The purpose of counselling session is to ensure that candidates get to know the institute and the department before they make a decision. A day long interaction session will help the candidates to understand the finer aspects of our M.Tech. program. You will get chance to talk to faculty members and current M.Tech. students. You can get to know the research work going on in various research group. You can see the campus, the infrastructure and most importantly the work culture to decide if this place is right for you.
- I am unable to attend counselling session on 15 May. What can I do?
Candidate attendance is necessary for the counselling session. Only in cases of medical emergency or clashing exam/admission schedule, we will exempt the candidate from attending the counselling session in-person. However, an authorized representative must attend the counselling session on the candidate's behalf. The call letter sent to the shortlisted candidates contains the template for the authorization letter. Prior approval is necessary for all such cases. Write an email to us (cseadmissions@iitg.ac.in) to obtain the approval.

We strongly discourage mass representation, that is a single person representing a large number of candidates. Mass representation defeats the purpose of arranging the counselling session. A single person can represent at the most two candidates only. A candidate can represent at the most one other candidate.
- When should I reach to IIT Guwahati for the counselling session?
We strongly recommend all outstation candidates to arrive in IITG campus on 14 May 2018.
- How to reach IIT Guwahati campus from airport / railway station?
From airport: IITG campus is about 23 km away from the airport.

From railway station: Guwahati city has two major railway stations, Kamakhya (distance 14 km) and Guwahati (distance 20 km).

Various taxi services including OLA and UBER are available from airport as well as railway stations.

- Where will I stay?

For a limited number of candidates, accommodation will be provided in the institute hostel. The room will have an empty bed without bedroll. The candidate needs to bring his/her own bedroll. Depending on the availability, the hostel care taker can provide bedroll on rent to a few candidates. If you want to avail hostel accommodation, then you have to register at the following link by Friday, May 3.

We cannot provide hostel accommodation without registration. Hostel accommodation will be available from Tuesday, May 14. You will have to vacate the hostel room by Thursday, May 16. Status of your hostel accommodation request will be communicated by Friday, May 10.

- What kind of food is available on campus?
Each hostel has a mess that provides breakfast, lunch, and dinner on payment basis. In addition, there are multiple canteens and restaurants on the campus that provide ample variety of food.
- Can you provide hostel accommodation for my parents / authorized representative?
No. However, Guwahati city has large number of hotels and it will be easy to find a suitable accommodation.
- What documents should I bring with me for the counselling session?
The call letter sent to you contains the list of required documents.
- Do I need to pay any fees during the counselling session?
No.
- Can I leave little early from the counselling session? I have early flight / train to catch.
No. Attending the entire session is necessary. We strongly recommend that you book return tickets on Thursday, May 16.
- When and how will I know if I am offered admission?
Admission offers will be made available only through the COAP portal. Follow the COAP portal for the timeline of various admission rounds.
