### TRAVEL SUPPORT, BOARDING & LODGING

### ELIGIBILITY, SELECTION & CONFIRMATION OF SEAT

The workshop is open to faculty members of AICTE/UGC approved universities / engineering / polytechnic colleges from North-East India preferably from CSE/IT/ECE/EEE and allied branches. However, faculty from other branches are also welcome. There will be a total of 30 seats for the workshop which will be filled based on first-come first-serve basis. The prime target will be participants from institutes in North-East India. Special preference will be given to women faculty members and members from backward classes and tribes. Faculty from other parts of India will be considered only if there are seats available after filling prime target members.

#### There is **NO REGISTRATION FEE**.

However, all interested candidates have to apply in the online application form. The scanned copy of the endorsement form duly signed by the head of the institute has also to be submitted in the online application form. If a participant is shortlisted based on the selection criteria, they have to confirm their availability for the workshop.
