Syllabus: Metrics and norms - metric spaces, normed vector spaces, convergence in metric spaces, completeness, pointwise and uniform convergence of sequence of functions; Functions of several variables - differentiability, chain rule, Taylor's theorem, inverse function theorem, implicit function theorem; Introduction to Lebesgue measure and integral - measurable sets, measurable functions, Lebesgue integral, dominated convergence theorem, monotone convergence theorem.
